THE RAILWAY STATION IS ONLY 1.5 KM FROM THE HOTEL. YOU CAN TAKE A TAXI (€ 8,00) AND ASK THEM TO TAKE YOU TO THE ANNUNZIATA HOTEL. YOU CAN ALSO WALK FROM THE STATION TO THE HOTEL (IT'S 15 MINUTES) IN THE DIRECTION OF THE CENTRE, CASTELLO ESTENSE.

TRAVELLING ON A GROUP TRIP

As you travel on a group trip, you will be exposed to all the pleasures and maybe some of the frustrations of travelling in a group. We ask you to understand your group's various needs and preferences – patience with your fellow travellers is sometimes required to benefit everyone's travel experience. Remember too that you have responsibilities to the group. If you are requested to be at a place at a specific time, ensure you don't keep the rest of the group waiting. We have found time and time again that the very best trips we operate are those where the dynamics within the group work well – this takes just a little effort on your part.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

We strongly recommend that all travellers have a policy covering personal liability, cancellation, curtailment and loss of luggage or personal effects.

PACKING

On this trip, you must pack as lightly as possible because you will be expected to carry your bag, and although you won't be required to walk long distances with your luggage (max 15 minutes), we strongly recommend keeping the weight under 20kg / 22lb. Smaller bags or backpacks with wheels are convenient. However, we recommend that your bag carry straps to accommodate the cobbled streets, uneven surfaces, stairs and steps you will likely to encounter while carrying your luggage. For day trips, you'll also need a pack/bag to bring water, a camera, etc. Clothing:

- Raincoat/waterproof jacket
- Pashmina or scarf to cover your shoulders
